

Camp Fee Refund Policy

Effective April 2026

This refund policy applies to all Seeds of Peace international delegations and participants enrolled in the Seeds of Peace International Camp. The following terms outline the conditions under which Camp fee refunds may be issued.

1. Visa Rejection

- Participants whose visa application to enter the Camp Host Country is denied will be eligible for a full refund, excluding any non-refundable visa application fees.

2. Participant-Initiated Cancellation

A. Cancellation One Month or Less Before Travel

- If a participant cancels within 30 days of the scheduled travel date, no refunds will be issued, except in extraordinary circumstances and at the sole discretion of Seeds of Peace.

B. Exceptional Circumstances

- In case of personal emergencies (e.g., death in the immediate family, serious illness, or other unforeseen emergencies), participants may be eligible for a partial refund of Camp fees.
- Refund amounts will be determined based on factors including the timing of cancellation, costs already incurred by the organization, and the nature of the circumstances. Earlier cancellations with lower incurred costs may result in higher refunds, while later cancellations may result in reduced refunds.
- This refund is subject to approval and requires the submission of supporting documentation (e.g., medical certificates, death certificates, etc.).

3. Missed Payment Deadlines

- Participants who fail to meet the established payment schedule may be excluded from the program and forfeit their place in the visa processing cohort.
- In such cases, any refund amount will be determined by the costs already incurred towards the programme by the organisation, including visa application, staffing costs, etc. A portion of the Camp fee may be retained to cover these incurred costs.

4. Camp Cancellation

- If Seeds of Peace cancels the Camp due to circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to government restrictions, changes in visa policies, travel disruptions, public health concerns, or safety and security conditions, participants will receive a refund of Camp fees paid.
- Refund amounts may be adjusted to account for non-recoverable costs already incurred by the organization. Any non-refundable third-party costs, such as visa application fees, will not be included in the refund.

5. General Conditions

- All refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Seeds of Peace Global Operations Team (claire@seedsofpeace.org) and local Country Director within 30 days of the triggering event.
- Refunds will be processed within approximately 30 days and issued via the original payment method when possible. Seeds of Peace reserves the right to modify or adjust this policy based on programmatic needs or country-specific requirements.
